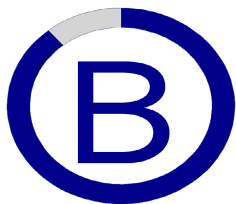

### Accountability Ratings

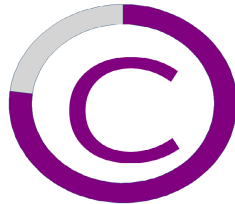

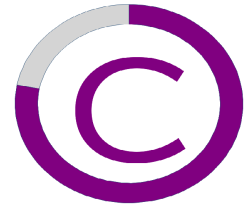

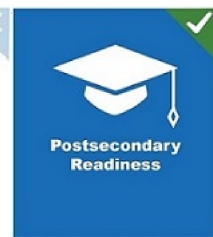
