- III. Opening Prayer

Mr. Felipe Morales, Choir Teacher at Mary Hoge Middle School, delivered the invocation.

- IV. Pledge of Allegiance/Texas Pledge

IX. Superintendent’s Report

- Community Scholarships

Mrs. Norma Brewer, Student Support Services Director, provide the following presentation:





- This year, staff established a committee to review fundraising procedures and selection of recipients, as well as a rubric system in order to give every student a fair opportunity to be eligible to receive a community scholarship. Information on the process was provided to students and parents. An online application was developed which allowed students to apply online from home or from their schools. Students were able to apply online from February 26 through March 23, 2018. The scoring rubric delineated the amount of points that were going to be provided for each area.
- Information was provided to students and parents through the following channels to ensure that everyone was well informed:
 - › Classroom presentations were provided by counselors.
 - › Letter from Dr. Canales was mailed out to all students.
 - › Flier with scholarship information was provided to all students.
 - › All-call system was utilized to remind students to apply and remind students about deadlines.
 - › Daily announcements were made at each campus.
 - › Announcement was provided on the Mid Valley Town Crier.
 - › Information was provided via KWES and social media.

The system will automatically select the schools that the applicants have attended and only those schools will receive the scholarship packets. Packets will have an applicant number and not a name.

Applications Received: 174 WEHS, 282 WHS, 21 CTE ECHS

- Packets are also provided to the campus scholarship committee with an applicant number and not a name. This will give the student a better opportunity and the campus committee will focus on the students’ strength, ACT scores, GPA, and rank information. The information is anonymous.
- Packets have been provided to the campuses. Each elementary school is receiving packets of only those applicants who attended those schools. The packet includes the scholarship application, the transcript with demographic information blacked out, and the teacher recommendation form. The teacher will receive an email advising them that the student is requesting a recommendation. The teacher will fill out and return the recommendation form.

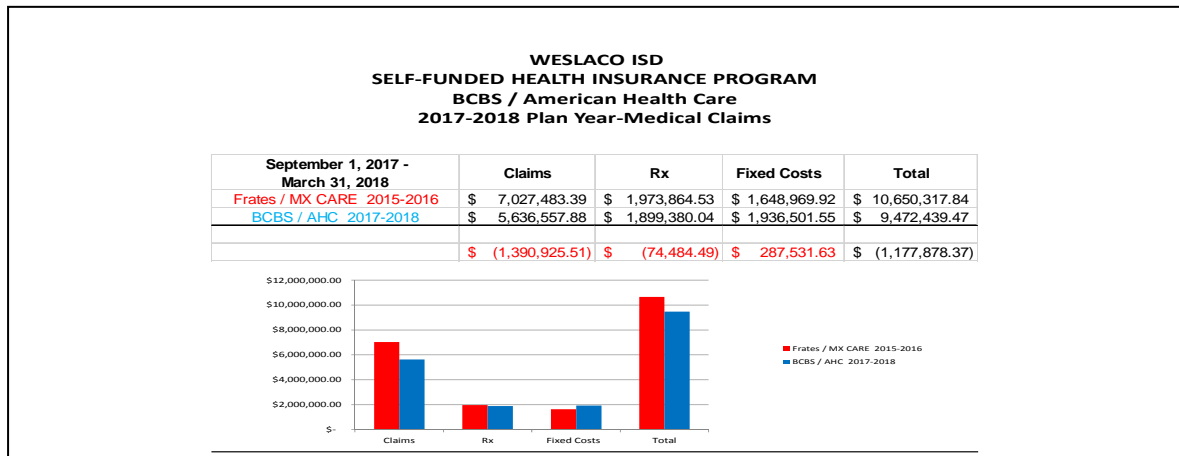
- Applications Received:
 - › Weslaco East High School – 174 (46%)
 - › Weslaco High School – 282 (51%)
 - › CTE Early College High School – 21 (30%)
- Questions from the Board:
 - › “What if the child has attended two different elementary schools?”
 - Both elementary schools will receive an application for that student.
 - › “What criteria is being used to determine who will receive a scholarship?”
 - The campus received a rubric that provides specific points for certain ACT scores, SAT scores, GPA, rank, community involvement, and extra-curricular activity. The committee reviews the application and points are given on the different areas. The students with the highest points are selected.
 - This is the first year the campus will use the rubric method.

According to Mrs. Brewer, they received only three calls from parents on students missing the deadline.

- › “Who served on the committee?”
 - Approximately 12 individuals: Mrs. Norma Brewer, Mrs. Sue Peterson, campus principals, parents, teachers and other directors.
- › “Did the counselors take it upon themselves to make sure that students were getting involved in looking for applications and applying?”
 - Every senior class was provided a presentation about the community scholarships. Every student had to sign a form stating that they attended the presentation and received the necessary information to apply on time.

● Insurance

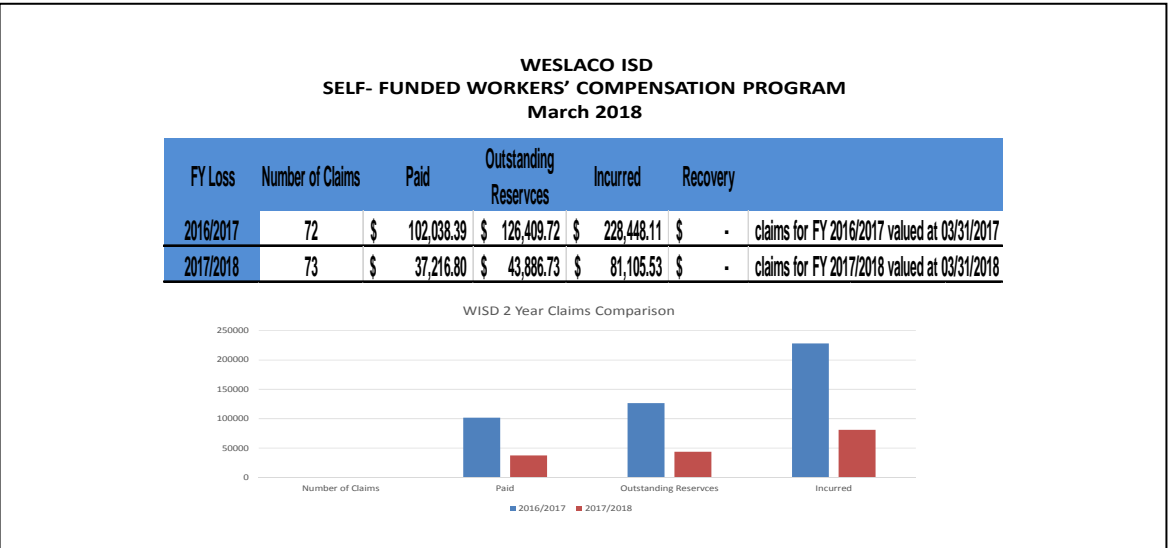
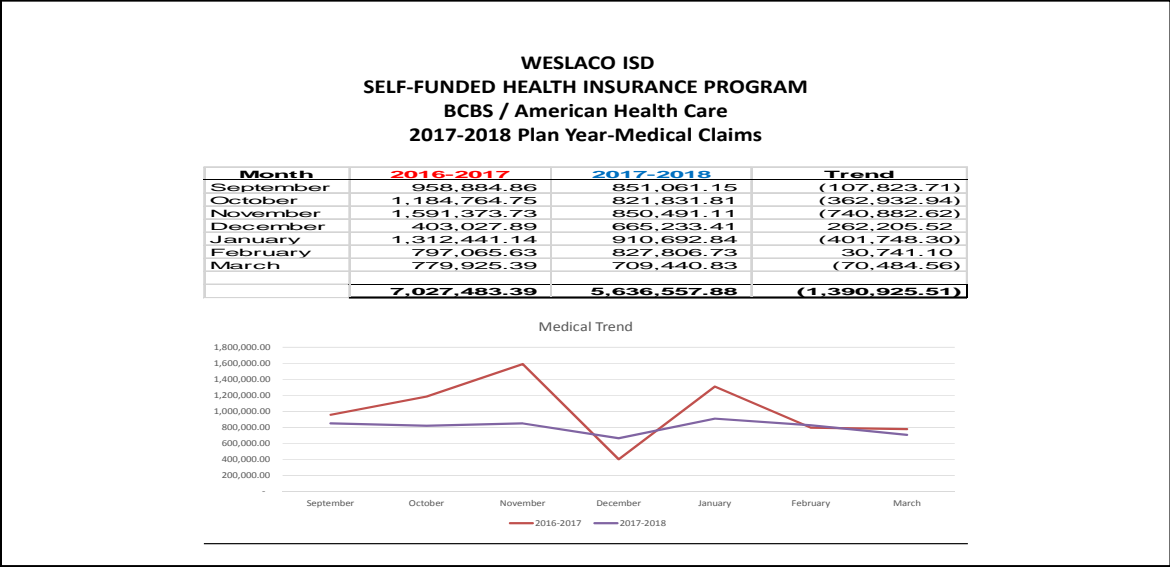
Mr. Mike De La Rosa, Risk Management/Employee Benefits Director, provided the following report on insurance.



- › The total spent for the health insurance plan in 2017-2018 for the period September 1st through March 31st was \$5,636,567.88 vs. \$7,027,483.39 spent in 2016-2017, for a difference of \$1,390,925.51 less.
- › The total spent, which includes claims, prescription costs, and fixed costs, for 2015-2016 was \$10,650,317.84 vs. \$9,472,439.47 spent in 2017-2018, for a difference of \$1,177,878.38 less.

Board President Erasmo Lopez commented that several years ago the district hired a company to check on the pharmaceutical benefits to ensure that the district was paying the correct amounts and getting the best prices. He wanted to know if this had been done.

Mr. De La Rosa explained that the insurance consultant conducted an evaluation about 5 years ago due to issues with the Pharmacy Benefit Management (PBM) Services. Results of the evaluation indicated that the district was paying a lot more for prescription drugs, so the district fired the PBM Services at mid-term.



› The number of claims filed last year were 72 vs. 73 filed this year. The total incurred in 2016-2017 was \$228,448.11 vs. \$43,886.73 in 2017-2018. The amount paid from these amounts in 2016-2017 was \$102,038.39 and \$43,886.73 in 2017-2018. According to Mr. De La Rosa, the Workmen’s Compensation Program is doing very well.

- The ADA of the first four six-weeks periods of the 2017-2018 school year is at 15,905 which results in a deficit of \$1,987,500. The ADA will be decreased next year from 16,170 to 15,905 in order to be conservative.

Dr. Rivera wanted to know from what accounts did staff plan to reduce the budget to make up the \$2 million deficit. According to Mr. Sanchez, there are positions that are budgeted in payroll which have not been filled and they also have funds that have not been spent. The vacancies are mainly teaching positions and a few central office positions that were never filled. Mr. Sanchez will provide information on the update of the amount anticipated for the positions not filled.

The Board President asked staff to study the numbers prior to reducing the ADA for budgeting purposes due to the number of apartment complexes being constructed in Weslaco which could possibly increase student enrollment at WISD.

Mr. Sanchez replied that he would rather budget at a lower number and if the enrollment increases and the ADA reflects that, he can increase the budget for the schools. Dr. Canales mentioned that staff has initiatives in place for the residences of those apartment complexes. Staff is also planning to do a block walking for open enrollment and will be going out to the areas where many families are relocating. Plans are to do the block walking before the end of April.

X. Consent Agenda

Dr. Richard Rivera pulled out Item B: Approval-of-Out of Valley Trips.

Isidoro Nieto made the motion to approve the consent agenda as presented with the exception of Item B. Patrick Kennedy seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

A. Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of March 20, 2018

The Board approved the minutes as presented.

B. Approval of Out of Valley Trips

This item was pulled out for discussion by Trustee Richard Rivera.

- C. Approval to Accept a Donation in the Amount of \$75.00 from Texas Music Educators Association Region Band (TMEA) for the Fine Arts Program

The Board accepted the \$75.00 donation from the Texas Music Educators Association Region Band (TMEA) for the Fine Arts Program. The funds were used to cover the cost of meals for the students who performed at the All Region Mariachi Clinic and Concert held on March 2 & 3, 2018, at the Performing Arts Center.

- D. Approval to Accept a Donation in the Amount of \$300.00 from the Almaraz Law Firm for Special Needs Students at Weslaco East High School

The Board accepted the \$300.00 donation from The Almaraz Law Firm as presented. The funds were used to purchase shirts for the special needs students at Weslaco East High School. The students wore the shirts on their field trip to the Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show in March.

- E. Approval to Accept Donation in the Amount of \$100.00 from Jeff Everitt & Associates, Inc. for the Weslaco East High School Girls Golf Tournament

The Board accepted the \$100.00 donation from Jeff Everitt & Associates, Inc. as presented. The funds were used to purchase snacks which were sold at the Girls Golf Tournament held on April 4th & 5th at Tierra Santa Golf Club.

- F. Approval of Interlocal Cooperation Contract Between Weslaco Independent School District and Texas Pre-Freshmen Engineering Program (TEX-PREP) at the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley

The Board approved the Interlocal Cooperation contract with the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley for the Texas Pre-Freshmen Engineering Program.

The Pre-Freshmen Engineering Program provides educational enrichment opportunities for high ability 7th through 11th grade students interested in pursuing Mathematics, Science, or Engineering degrees. Students participate in a seven-week summer program. The primary goal of TexPREP is to improve access to careers in Mathematics, Sciences, and Engineering. In order to achieve this goal, the program includes: academics, role modeling, mentoring, hands on experience, and career awareness.

The cost will be \$390 for each student who is certified as being in attendance on the fifth day of the program (June 12). WISD will provide transportation for students to and from the university. A total of ten students have applied and have qualified for the program. The High school allotment funds (166) will be used for this program.

- G. Approval of Extension of Proposal Award for Lumber Supplies & Equipment – Extension (Proposal #17-04-34)

The Board awarded the extension for lumber supplies and equipment to the following vendors:

The three vendors have agreed to continue the contract with all three vendors listed as awarded in April 2017. Any purchase for lumber supplies with an estimated cost of \$500 or less will require only one quote from the appropriate vendor. However, purchases for lumber supplies greater than \$500 will require quotes from both of the approved vendors. All millwork, regardless of amount, will be purchased from South Texas Molding and will require a quote.

The total amount of purchases for one year cannot be determined now since it is not known how much each department or campus will purchase.

H. Approval of Quarterly Investment Activity Report for the Quarter Ended February 28, 2018

House Bill No. 2459 passed in 1995 requires that the Investment Officer(s) of a governing body prepare a written quarterly report of investment transactions for all funds for the preceding reporting period.

The Board approved the Quarterly Investment report for the quarter ended February 28, 2018 as presented.

I. Approval to Verify and Document the Agreement Between Weslaco ISD and the Hidalgo County Appraisal District to Continue with the Modified Quarterly Payment Schedule of Fees to the Hidalgo County Appraisal District

The Board approved the agreement with Hidalgo County Appraisal District for the purpose of continuing with the existing modified quarterly payment schedule of fees to the Hidalgo County Appraisal District.

In 1982, the taxing units and the former Chief Appraiser agreed to modify the provisions of Section 6.06 (e), and agreed to establish four equal payments as follows:

- 1st Quarter Invoices mailed January 2nd – Due on February 2nd
- 2nd Quarter Invoices mailed March 10th – Due on April 10th
- 3rd Quarter Invoices mailed June 10th – Due on July 10th
- 4th Quarter Invoices mailed September 10th – Due on October 10th

The Hidalgo County Appraisal District has asked all taxing entities to re-verify and document the agreement in order to continue with the existing modified quarterly payment schedule of fees as approved in 1982.

J. Approval of Budget Amendments

The Board approved the budget amendments as presented.

1. Bilingual Department – State Bilingual Fund to Purchase 51 Scanners for the Counselors at All 20 Campuses that Conduct Language Proficiency Assessments: \$21,420
2. Nursing Department – Local Maintenance Fund to Record Purchase of New AEDs (Automated External Defibrillators) to be Distributed to All Schools and Departments: \$122,530

K. Approval to Accept a Donation in the Amount of \$300.00 from Mr. A.C. Cuellar and JIII Concrete for the Counseling Department at Rudy Silva Elementary School

The Board accepted the \$300.00 donation from Mr. A.C. Cuellar and J-III Concrete as presented. The funds will be used to purchase items for the student center in the counseling department at Rudy Silva Elementary.

L. Ratify Approval on Changing the Regular Board Meeting from April 9, 2018 to April 10, 2018

The Board ratified previous approval granted by the Board to change the Regular Board Meeting scheduled on Monday, April 9, 2018 to Tuesday, April 10, 2018.

All board members and superintendent will be attending the National School Boards Association (NSBA) Conference in San Antonio, Texas on April 6-9, 2018, and are expected to return on Monday evening, the day of the board meeting.

Items Pulled Out for Discussion:

This item was pulled out for discussion by Dr. Richard Rivera. Dr. Rivera stressed the importance of having proper supervision during these field trips. He stated, “We need to take care of our kids. There are too many things that can happen. Take care of our kids.”

Andrew Gonzalez made the motion to approve the trips as presented. Oscar Caballero seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

PFC Mario Ybarra Elementary School

- The 4th grade students will visit the Texas State Aquarium at Corpus Christi, Texas on April 13, 2018. This trip will provide a real life experience and enrich the learning acquired by viewing historical artifacts and to teach important science skills and demonstrate what scientist do.

Weslaco East High School

- The UIL students will have the opportunity to participate in the UIL Regional Academic Competition at UTSA in San Antonio, Texas on April 13-14, 2018. These students placed at the district competition and advanced to regional competition. Students will now compete to earn a place at state competition.
- The Drama students will have the opportunity to attend the state UIL One Act Play competition at Round Rock ISD PAC, Round Rock, Texas on April 25-26, 2018. This two-day performance will provide students the experience to learn commands and be commanded.

- Two male students will attend the Texas Boys State in Austin, Texas from June 10-15, 2018. Three or five additional students might be attending at no additional cost to the district. Students will learn about the duties, privileges, and leadership in the political process.
- The Choir students will have the opportunity to attend and compete in the American Classic Bluebonnet Festival in San Antonio, Texas on April 27-28, 2018. This trip will provide students an opportunity to help them improve individually and hear choirs from around the State of Texas. Students will also compete for individual awards.
- The Visual Art students will attend the State Visual Arts Scholastic Event to be held in San Marcos, Texas on April 27-29, 2018. These students will experience a level of competition, engage in workshops, and participate in TAEA recommended sites of interest that will encourage them to utilize 21st century learning skills and prepare for college.
- The Girls Golf Team will attend the 32-6A Regional Golf Tournament in San Antonio, Texas on April 24-26, 2018. The athletes will have an opportunity to compete at the next competitive level as they prepare for the State Tournament.
- The Girls Track Team will attend the Regional Track & Field Meet in San Antonio, Texas on April 26-28, 2018. The athletes will have an opportunity to compete at the next competitive level as they prepare for the State Meet.
- The Boys Track Team will attend the Regional Track & Field Meet in San Antonio, Texas on April 26-28, 2018. The athletes will have an opportunity to compete at the next competitive level as they prepare for the State Meet.
- The Criminal Justice members will participate in a field trip to tour the Witte Museum and visit Fiesta Texas in San Antonio, Texas on Friday, April 27, 2018. Students will be exposed to multi-sensory experiences, promote cooperative learning, foster critical thinking in science, art, and history, encourage creativity, and invite interactions with the real thing: specimens, artifacts and works of art.

Weslaco High School

- The UIL Teams will participate in the UIL Regional Contest in San Antonio, Texas on April 12-15, 2018. These athletes placed at the district contest which allowed them to advance to the Regional Contest. This trip will provide them the opportunity to demonstrate their skills at the regional level of competition.
- The Art students will attend the UIL Visual Art Scholastic Event in San Marcos, Texas on April 27-28, 2018. Students will present their artwork created in their art classes and be interviewed by a certified juror who will evaluate their work based on standards based on rubric and their understanding of the art processes involved in the development of their artwork. Students will also participate in professional workshops, lectures, slide presentations, demonstrations, and outdoor sketching opportunities.
- The Health Science Community seniors will participate in the Fiesta Texas Learning Outside the Classroom Event on May 4, 2018 at San Antonio, Texas. Prior approval was granted at the March 20th Board meeting but due to two special education students attending, resubmission was necessary in order to accommodate the students with their costs and chaperones who will be assisting. Students will participate in activities that will allow them to see mathematical formulas, physical science, economic terminology, and real world application being used in methods that are outside of the classroom activities.

- The Girls Golf Team will attend the Regional Golf Tournament in San Antonio, Texas on April 24-26, 2018. Athletes will compete at the 6A Regional Golf Tournament to prepare for the State Meet.
- The Boys Golf Team will attend the Regional Golf Tournament in San Antonio, Texas on April 22-24, 2018. Athletes will have the opportunity to represent WISD at the Regional Tournament.
- The Band and Orchestra students will compete at the UIL Texas State Solo & Ensemble Contest on May 27-28, 2018 at the University of Texas at Austin. The students will compete and represent Weslaco High school to a higher level of competition with students all over the state of Texas.

Weslaco High School and Weslaco East High School

- Forty students in the Auto Collision Program will attend and participate in the Toyota Texas Plant Tour program in San Antonio, Texas on May 11, 2018. Students will experience the automobile assembly process. Toyota has a Visitor and Education Center where students will have access to information and videos on the history of Toyota and how vehicles are built today.
- The FCCLA National Leadership Conference will be held in Atlanta, Georgia on June 28 through July 2, 2018. Students will compete at the national level in Students Taking Actions for Recognition (STAR) Events, participating in leadership development workshops, and serving as voting delegates.

CTE Early College High School

- The Agriscience students will attend and participate at the Floriculture and Landscape Nursery workshop to be held in Seguin, Texas on April 6, 2018. Students will compete in CDE events which are designed to help students prepare for a career in agriculture by testing and challenging the student's technical, leadership, and teamwork skills.

Weslaco High School, Weslaco East High School and CTE Early College

- The Agriscience students will attend and participate at the Area X Dairy Cattle Career Development Event to be held in Floresville, Texas on April 5-6, 2018. Students will compete in CDE events which are designed to help students prepare for a career in agriculture by testing and challenging the student's technical, leadership, and teamwork skills.

WISD Migrant Students

Forty Priority for Service (PFS) migrant students will participate in the "2018 Close Up Washington D.C. & New York High School Summer Program. This trip will enhance and develop attitudes and skills needed to become informed and engaged citizens. Students will participate in leadership workshops that address community issues, student led-mock congress, and issues regarding the economy.

WISD Folkloric Dance Group

Fourteen students will attend the convention, workshops, and perform folkloric dances in front of a panel of master teachers that have an array of experience and many years of teaching experience in the folklorico field. In addition, the students will visit Arizona State University to tour the campus and view performances that may lead to post-secondary career opportunities.

A. Interim Financial Report for the Seven Months Ended March 31, 2018

The Board acknowledged the Interim Financial Reports for the seven months ended March 31, 2018 as prepared by the Business Office.

Mr. Andres Sanchez, Assistant Superintendent of Business and Finance, presented the following report.

 - › The District has spent \$94,244,014 through March 31 which represents 53.90%.

Dr. Rivera questioned if the District ever had a balanced budget. Mr. Sanchez replied that the budget was balanced, but after the school year started staff made some amendments to the fund balance which included purchases for computers and some other items. Staff rolled forward some budgets like state comp. There were state comp funds that had not been spent and ended up in fund balance at the end of the 2016-17 fiscal year. Staff prepared the budget amendments to distribute it to the different accounts that they needed to go into.

Dr. Rivera requested an update on the following:

- ›How much money has the district spent on consultants from different functions?
- ›How much money has the district spent on attorney fees from Function 41?

XII. Discussion and Possible Action Items:

A. Discussion and Possible Action to Approve the 2018-2019 Academic Calendar

Each campus was invited to submit a calendar for the 2018-2019 school year to the Calendar Committee, a sub-committee of the District Advisory Committee. The committee was composed of a representative from each campus. The committee reviewed the calendars and narrowed the selection down to three options. Parents, students, and staff were given the opportunity to view and vote on the three calendar options on-line from March 22nd through March 29th.

Mrs. Sue Peterson, Assistant Superintendent for Secondary Education and Leadership, informed the Board that Calendar 3 received the most votes. Calendar 3 included participation from teachers, parents, students, and school-non teachers. This calendar has fewer days of instruction, 162 vs. 168 days included in Calendar 1 and 2. In addition, Calendar 3 has 76,560 minutes for the high schools and 77,040 for the middle and elementary schools. The difference between the minutes available for the grade levels is due to two additional early release days for the high schools. Calendar 3 received 889 votes, Calendar 1 received 697 votes, and Calendar 2 received 330 votes.

Calendar 1 which was similar to last year's calendar included participation from district staff only: teachers, school non-teachers, and departments. This calendar received 387 votes. Calendar 2 received 130 votes, and Calendar 3 received 293. According to Mrs. Peterson, Principals preferred Calendar 1. All categories of campus-based staff voted in favor of this calendar as well.

Mr. Gonzalez commented that a few years ago the Board voted in favor of a calendar heavily dominated by the students, and later realized that they needed to put emphasis on a calendar also favored by the principals and staff.

Patrick Kennedy made the motion to approve Calendar 1. Isidoro Nieto seconded the motion.

Dr. Rivera questioned the purpose of the enrichment days and if teachers were being paid for these days.

Mrs. Peterson explained that during the enrichment days in May students will be invited to attend school and participate in activities for remediation, acceleration, and enrichment. However, students are not required to participate. Campuses are already planning various activities that include: recovery options, Stem, and Fine Arts. Teachers will not receive additional compensation as these days are part of the 187 contract days. Regular summer school will begin on June 4th.

Dr. Rivera expressed his concern on reducing the actual instructional days for students to 168. He pointed out that the test scores for WISD were below Region One in many areas and therefore he was concerned on having less instructional days. He asked staff to provide information on their weekly update on the number of instructional days approved by the bigger school districts like McAllen, Harlingen, and Brownsville.

Mr. Lopez requested information on the number of instructional days WISD has provided for the past five (5) years.

Oscar Caballero asked staff to include the two-week district closure on the school calendar to ensure that all employees have this information for vacation purposes.

The Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion made by Patrick Kennedy and seconded by Isidoro Nieto to approve Calendar 1.

B. Discussion and Possible Action for the Board to Approve the Memorandum of Understanding Between Weslaco Independent School District and South Texas College for the Continuation of the Weslaco T-STEM Early College High School, Weslaco East T-STEM Early College High School, and Weslaco 21st Century CTE ECHS for the 2018-2019 School Year

TEA requires school districts with Early College programs to submit an annual application and gain annual approval for the MOU with their higher education partner. Therefore, WISD will continue working with STC to offer the at-risk population at WISD the opportunity to graduate with an Associate's Degree while enrolled in high school. The intent and goal of the Early College High Schools is to provide a nurturing atmosphere for students that require extra support systems and accelerated programs to help them succeed. This experience prepares students to be college and career ready as they make a commitment to enroll in a complete dual enrollment curriculum which will enable them to attain a 60 or more college hours and complete an associate's degree. The school attorney has reviewed and modified the agreement.

Dr. Rivera made the motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Weslaco Independent School District and South Texas College for the continuation of the Weslaco T-STEM Early College High School, Weslaco East T-STEM Early College High School, and Weslaco 21st Century CTE ECHS for the 2018-2019 School Year. Dr. Rodriguez seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

C. Discussion and Possible Action for the Board to Approve the Revision to (Local) Policy FDB Admissions: Intradistrict Transfers and Classroom Assignments

Parents of students who wish to transfer their children to a school outside their attendance zone are required to submit a transfer to the Superintendent or designee in June according to district policy.

The district would like to change the submission date to May instead of June to allow district campuses to plan accordingly for the following academic year.

Dr. Rivera made the motion to approve the revision to (Local) Policy FDB Admissions: Intradistrict Transfers and Classroom Assignments as presented. Oscar Caballero seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

D. Discussion and Possible Action for the Board to Consider: 1) Approval of the Administration's Recommendation of the Ranking of the Proposals Received for the Construction of the Chemical Storage Building for the Aquatic Center, and 2) To Authorize Administration to Enter into Contract Negotiations and Approve a Contract for this Project (CSP #18-04-20)

On February 13, 2017, the Board approved the project for the construction of the Chemical Storage building. On April 8, 2017, the Board approved the hiring of Rike Ogden Figueroa Alex (ROFA) Architects, Inc. to design the plans and specifications. On January 15, 2018, the Board voted to approve the competitive sealed proposal method of construction, delegated the ranking authority to the Administration, and approved the criteria and points.

After reviewing the five (5) proposals received, the ranking committee recommended that the project be awarded to Mata Construction of Penitas, Texas.

Dr. Rivera asked if all references had been checked. Mr. Sanchez replied, "Yes."

Dr. Richard Rivera made the motion to award the project to Mata Construction of Penitas, Texas, and to authorize Administration to enter into contract negotiations and approve the contract once it has been reviewed by the attorney. Dr. Jaime Rodriguez seconded the motion.

Trustee Andrew Gonzalez pointed out that the budgeted amount for this project was at \$100,000 and now the project cost is at \$175,000.

Mr. Sanchez replied that several items such as the louver for ventilation were added to the project which increased the cost.

Mr. Gonzalez questioned the need for the added protection of chemicals. He was concerned with the cost difference and wanted to make sure that there was enough money to complete all the other projects.

According to Athletic Director Oscar Riojas, muriatic acid and chlorine tablets will be stored in the storage building and they will need some type of ventilation system to allow the building to breath. Due to the upcoming summer swimming program, more chemicals will be needed and staff will need to store these in a safe, ventilated area for the safety of the kids.

Board President Erasmo Lopez commented that the chemicals are very costly but they will eat up the equipment.

The Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion made by Dr. Richard Rivera and seconded by Dr. Jaime Rodriguez to award the project to Mata Construction of Penitas, Texas, and to authorize Administration to enter into contract negotiations and approve the contract once it has been reviewed by the attorney.

- E. Discussion and Possible Action for the Board to Consider: 1) Approval of the Administration's Recommendation of the Ranking of the Proposals Received for the Construction of the Parking Lot Additions at Rodolfo (Rudy) Silva Elementary School & Justice Raul Gonzalez Elementary School, and 2) To Authorize Administration to Enter into Contract Negotiations and Approve a Contract for this Project (CSP #18-04-24)

On February 13, 2017, the Board approved the parking lot additions project. On April 10, 2017, the Board approved the hiring of M Garcia Engineering LLP to design the plans and specifications. On April 10, 2018, the Weslaco ISD School Board voted to approve the competitive sealed proposal method of construction, delegated the ranking authority to the Administration, and approved the criteria and points.

This project will provide additional parking spaces for the convenience of all visitors to Silva and Gonzalez Elementary schools. Teachers and staff will have adequate lighted parking at their respective campuses.

After reviewing the seven (7) proposals received, the ranking committee recommended that this project be awarded to NM Contracting, LLC from McAllen, Texas at a cost of \$281,336.00. Funding for this project will be paid from the Fund Balance Assigned for Facilities or Other Needs in the Local Maintenance Fund. The district budgeted \$441,000 for this project and thus will have money left over.

Andrew Gonzalez made the motion to approve NM Contracting, LLC from McAllen, Texas as recommended by the administration. Isidoro Nieto seconded the motion.

Mr. Gonzalez wanted to know if the company had the manpower to complete this project since they are also doing the field house project. Mr. Sanchez replied that NM Contracting is a big company and they have the manpower to work on both projects.

The Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion made by Andrew Gonzalez and seconded by Isidoro Nieto to approve NM Contracting, LLC from McAllen, Texas as recommended by the administration.

- F. Discussion and Possible Action for the Board to Consider Approval of the Final Completion, Change Order and Final Payment for the Electrical Upgrades Project at Margo Elementary School (CSP #17-07-62)

On June 19, 2017, the Board approved the Administration's recommendation to award the electrical upgrades project to Zitro Electric, LLC. The estimated amount for this project was \$475,000. The total cost for this project came out to \$427,900.00.

The administration recommended approval of the final completion for this project, the deductive change order to deduct the cost of contingency allowance which was not used, and the final payment to the contractor.

According to Mr. Sanchez, the project is going well and all warranties are in place. All punch list items were taken care of by the contractor and the principal at Margo Elementary is satisfied with the work performed.

Dr. Jaime Rodriguez made the motion to approve the final completion for this project, the deductive change order to deduct the cost of contingency allowance which was not used, and the final payment to the contractor as recommended by the administration. Patrick Kennedy seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

G. Discussion and Possible Action for the Board to Consider Approval of the Administration's Recommendation for the Financing of the New Digital Scoreboard for Bobby Lackey Stadium

Mr. Andres Sanchez, Assistant Superintendent for Business and Finance, provided the following information on the financing of the scoreboard for Bobby Lackey Stadium.

- The District received two (2) financing offers:

Amount Financed: \$1,356,568

1. Texas National Bank
 - › 5.25% (commercial rate) for 5 years only (60 months)
 - › The District has to refinance at the end of 5 years at which time the rate could possibly increase.
2. PNC Equipment Finance Company
 - › 5.95% fixed rate per year (commercial rate, not tax exempt debt)
 - › 88 months (7 years & 3 months)
 - › The agreement has been reviewed by Mr. David Mendez with Bickerstaff Heath Delgado Acosta LLP, legal counsel.

Mr. Mendez recommended approval for the financing of the new digital scoreboard from PNC Equipment Finance, and in the form as substantially modified by legal counsel and with the terms listed above at 5.95% fixed rate per year for 88 months.

The board members addressed the following concerns:

- ›Dr. Rivera stated that the interest rate was too high and questioned the zero percent interest rate. He said that his district received a loan at a zero percent interest rate from Daktronics about 6 or 8 months ago.
- ›Mr. Lopez wanted to know if the District had money at Texas National Bank other than for payroll purposes. He was surprised that the bank did not offer a lower interest rate being that they are the district's depository bank. Mr. Lopez also agreed that the 5.95% rate was too high and he felt that it should be more in the range of 3 to 4 percent.
 - According to Mr. Sanchez, the district does not have additional funds in Texas State Bank. The lowest rate offered at this bank was 5.25% for a 5 year period and the loan would have to be refinanced at the end of the 60 months.
- ›Dr. Rivera questioned the number of ads available, date of installation, and the due date for the first payment of the loan.
 - Mr. Carlos Robledo, KWES Director, explained that there is an unlimited amount of ads that can be displayed since the scoreboard is digital. The district currently has five (5) ads at \$5,000 per year. Staff is looking at getting some big sponsors and other local vendors and selling the naming rights to the football field.
 - Advertising revenue is currently at approximately \$80,000 annually. Mr. Caballero pointed out that since there are more options for advertising, the amount of revenue could possibly increase.
 - According to Mr. Sanchez, the payment amount could be about \$175,000. The payment date has not been set but it could be September 1, 2018. He explained that the company would set up an escrow account for WISD in the full amount. As the scoreboard progresses, the company would be paid with money deposited in the escrow account.

›The scoreboard could be ready by the end of August or early September. The first home football game is scheduled to be held September 6th. Staff does not plan to remove the existing scoreboard until the new one is installed and operational.

Mr. Lopez pointed out staff will be able to show the game on the whole screen, or on a 10 x 10 screen which will allow advertisements to be displayed all the way around. He asked the school attorney if they could approve this item and have the administration look for a cheaper rate, or would they have to accept the terms presented if approved. The school attorney recommended that the Board either approve or disapprove the recommendation at this time or take no action and proceed to look for a better rate.

Mr. Kennedy commented that too many advertisements on the scoreboard would look gaudy and would take away from the scoreboard so he would prefer to shop around and look for a cheaper rate. He stated, “The school district has a good financial rating with investment brokers and it is guaranteed money. Anyone who wants this money is gonna get their money back plus extra on the interest rate, and I think banks may be willing to compete in order to get that money and maybe we can get a lower rate.”

Mr. Sanchez confirmed the term of the loan based on information received by PNC via text. The payment amount would be \$211,000 per year. The interest would be \$331,000 for 7.3 years at a fixed rate for the entire period.

Mr. Lopez questioned the timeline for completing this project and if the company had guaranteed that the scoreboard would be ready by September 1st. Coach Riojas reiterated that staff was not going to remove the existing scoreboard in case the new scoreboard was not ready. The term is 120 days once the contract has been signed, so if the project is started by May 1st and the weather is good, they should have it completed in time. In addition, the engineer will need time to review the plans.

Mr. Kennedy suggested that staff obtain at least seven (7) quotes from other banks and bring this item back in a week. Mr. Lopez wanted to know if the district had to advertise. According to Mr. Sanchez, the district is required to advertise when they spend money for the district, but in this case, the district is obtaining a loan.

Mr. Kennedy preferred that staff try and obtain quotes to see if the district could get a lower interest rate due to the amount being financed.

Andrew Gonzalez made the motion to table the item and for staff to bring it back during a special meeting in the coming week. Patrick Kennedy seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
