### **Introduction:**

The 84th Legislative Session passed House Bill 1842, allowing Texas public school districts to become Districts of Innovation and thus permitting exemption from certain provisions of the Texas Education Code. To better serve and accommodate the diverse needs of all members, Weslaco ISD seeks to become a District of Innovation. This distinction allows the District to increase local control over the District calendar to improve the quality of services benefiting all Stakeholders.

Currently, our district follows Policy EB (Legal) which states the following on the School Start Date:

A district may not begin instruction for students for a school year before the fourth Monday in August unless the district operates a year-round system.

We are proposing the following exception on TEC Sec. 25.0811. **FIRST DAY OF INSTRUCTION.** (a) Except as this section provides, a school district may not begin instruction for students for a school year before the fourth MONDAY in August.

Exempting from the requirements of the Texas Education Code provisions listed above will provide the following benefits to our WISD community.

#### Benefits -

- Allow for flexible PD opportunities throughout the year.
- More instructional days before STAAR/EOC
- Instructional days are aligned with Institutions of Higher Education
- Address Attendance patterns and concerns
- Minimize stress by implementing wellness days/ fall break
- Reduce Summer Learning Loss
- Grade Reporting will be balanced per semester
- More time to complete our PEIMS coding before the Fall (Snapshot) submission.
- Flexibility of start and end times for daily schedules while still complying with the 75,600 instructional minutes
- Provides the flexibility to allow more time for classroom preparation time to ensure high-quality instruction
