## **BOUNDARY LINES FOR OUT-OF-DISTRICT STUDENTS**

We use North, South, East, West, Texas Blvd. and Expressway 83 as the boundary lines for determining what school(s) the Out-of-District student would feed into:

### **Elementary students coming from:**

North/West (Donna) would go to Cleckler/Heald, Gonzalez or Silva

South/West Donna would go to Memorial, Sam Houston or Roosevelt

North-East (Mercedes) would go to Ybarra, Rico or North Bridge

South-East (Mercedes) would go to Margo, Airport or Roosevelt

North-West (Elsa) would go to Gonzalez, Silva or Cleckler/Heald

North-East (Edcouch) would go to Ybarra, Rico, North Bridge

South-West (Progresso) would go to Memorial, Margo, or Roosevelt

South-East (Progresso) would go to Margo, Sam Houston or Roosevelt

### **MIDDLE SCHOOL AND SECONDARY**

These schools follow the same basic procedures using the same boundaries as the Elementary schools.

| NO INTERDISTRICT TRANSFERS                                       | A nonresident student shall not be permitted to attend District schools except as provided below.  |
| EXCEPTIONS   | A resident student who becomes a nonresident during the course of a semester shall be permitted to continue in attendance for the remainder of the semester.   |
| FORMER RESIDENT  | A nonresident student who has attended one of the District's schools for a minimum of one year prior to becoming a nonresident may be permitted to attend a District school.   |
| SIBLINGS   | The sibling of a nonresident student who qualifies under former resident currently enrolled may be permitted to attend a District school.  |
| NONRESIDENT DISTRICT EMPLOYEES                                   | <p>A nonresident District employee may request that his or her child be admitted into District schools by filing an application with the Superintendent or designee. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time, on a tuition-free basis.</p> <p>When the parent or guardian is no longer employed by the District, the student may continue his or her enrollment in the District until the end of the semester in which the employment termination took place.</p>   |
| NONRESIDENT PROPERTY OWNER                                       | A nonresident parent owning real property and paying District school taxes may request that his or her child be admitted into District schools by filing an application with the Superintendent or designee, and providing proof of ownership and a tax receipt. Transfers shall be granted for one regular year at a time, on a tuition-free basis.   |
| NONRESIDENT PARTICIPANT OF THE EARLY LEARNING FOUNDATION ACADEMY | Students who are three or four years of age (on or before September 1) who participate in the collaborative project between the District and the Hidalgo County Head Start program, a participating day care center or a teaching and mentoring community program, or who qualify based on the eligibility criteria for one of the above named programs shall be enrolled and served by the District's Early Learning Foundation Academy.  |
| EMPLOYMENT WITHIN THE DISTRICT                                   | <p>A nonresident parent employed by a business within the District's boundaries may request that his or her child be admitted into District schools by filing an application with the Superintendent or designee. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time, on a tuition-free basis, provided the following provisions are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The nonresident parent's employer pays District school taxes;</li><li>2. The nonresident parent provides proof of employment; and</li></ol> |

3. The business has a minimum of three employees, or
4. The business has been open for a minimum of one year.

TRANSFER  
REQUESTS

A nonresident student wishing to transfer into the District shall file an application for transfer each school year with the Superintendent or designee. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time.

FACTORS

In approving transfers, the Superintendent or designee shall consider availability of space and instructional staff and the student's disciplinary history and attendance records.

TRANSFER  
AGREEMENTS

A transfer student shall be notified in the written transfer agreement that he or she must follow all rules and regulations of the District. Violation of the terms of the agreement may result in a transfer request not being approved the following year.

TRANSPORTATION

The District shall not provide transportation for nonresident transfer students.

TUITION

If the District charges tuition, the amount shall be set by the Board, within statutory limits.

WAIVERS

The Board may waive tuition for a student based on financial hardship upon written application by the student, parent, or guardian. [See FP]

NONPAYMENT

The District may initiate withdrawal of students whose tuition payments are delinquent.

APPEALS

Any appeals shall be made in accordance with FNG(LOCAL) and GF(LOCAL), as appropriate.
